

St. John: In the Beginning was the Word __ the Light:: KJV Bible 1:1-14

Jo 1:1 In the beginning was [the Word](#), and **the Word** was with God, and **the Word** was God.

Jo 1:2 The same was in the beginning with God.

Jo 1:3 All things were made by him; and without him was not any thing made that was made.

Jo 1:4 In him was life; and the life was **the light** of men.

Jo 1:5 And [the light](#) shineth in darkness; and the darkness comprehended it not.

Jo 1:6 There was a man sent from God, whose name was **John {the Baptist}**.

Jo 1:7 The same came for a witness, to bear witness of **the Light**, that all men through him might believe.

Jo 1:8 He was not **that Light**, but was sent to bear witness of **that Light**.

Jo 1:9 That was the **true Light**, which lighteth every man that cometh into the world.

Jo 1:10 He was in the world, and the world was made by him, and the world knew him not.

Jo 1:11 He came unto his own, and his own received him not.

Jo 1:12 But as many as received him, to them gave he power to become the **sons of God**, even to them that believe on his name:

Jo 1:13 Which were born, not of blood, nor of the will of the flesh, nor of the will of man, but of God.

Jo 1:14 And **the Word** was made flesh, and dwelt among us, (and we beheld his glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father,) full of grace and truth.
